Be cautious of offers that promise large sums of money or guaranteed returns with little effort.

If something feels off, trust your instincts and contact your bank directly to verify.

PRIVACY IS THE KEY TO SAFETY

Keep your passwords private, and do not share them with anyone, especially over text, email, or phone.

If you're ever unsure, pause and contact your bank directly—protecting your information starts with you.

IMPOSTER ACCOUNTS ON SOCIAL MEDIA

That celebrity giveaway or urgent message from a "friend"? It could be a scam. Fraudsters clone profiles or create fake ones to lure victims.

Always verify through other channels if something feels off—and don't click random links from unfamiliar accounts.

ALWAYS THINK BEFORE YOU CLICK!

Never click on suspicious links or download unexpected attachments—phishing scams often look like legitimate messages from trusted sources.
